## General Information

- All Auskick Coordinators and coaches are requested to ensure teams are assembled at least fifteen minutes prior to their first match on the day.
- All teams will play two matches during the carnival.
- Can all coaches make sure they have a manager assigned for the day to ensure everything runs smoothly and to minimise delays.
- Auskick coaches of each side will be umpiring matches together. Please make sure you bring a whistle.
- At the conclusion of each game, can you please make sure the match day footballs are returned to the team that supplied them.
- Food stalls will be set up on both ovals with coffee vans available & canteen open.
- CLAREMONT FC PLAYERS WILL BE ON THE FIELD TO THROW THE BALL UP THEN THEY WILL BE INTERACTING/HELPING THE PLAYERS ON THE FIELD. THEY ARE NOT THERE TO UMPIRE.
- Oval Size will remain the same across all age groups for Gala Day.
  - 35m x 25m

## Match Rules

- Both teams must play equal numbers where possible.
  - Pre-Primary: 6-per side
  - Year 1: 9-per side
  - Year 2: 9-per side
- The matches will be two 8-minute halves with a 4-minute break at half time.
- During half time, teams will be changing ends. Please mix up the players positions during this time.
- The oval will be marked in two halves for coach's reference points.
- At the end of each game, there will be a 5-minute break before the next round.
- All teams are to supply their own goal umpire, goal flags and strip.
- At the conclusion of the last round (Round 14 & 15), it would be greatly appreciated if goal posts, covers and markers could be carried back to the main changing rooms. Please assign parents to fulfil this duty.

## Inclement Weather

1. Play will CONTINUE if the following conditions are experienced.
  - i. Intermittent rain.
  - ii. Continual rain for a period no longer than one hour.
2. Play will STOP if the following conditions are experienced.

- i. Torrential rain for a period of over 30 minutes.
  - ii. Continual rain, which develops into hail.
  - iii. Persistently strong or gale force winds.
  - iv. A 30-minute waiting period will be put into place. If the weather has not improved, the day will be called off.
- 3.** Coordinators, coaches and parents will be advised via the loud speaker if the conditions are unsuitable for playing. The carnival coordinator will make the final decision.
- 4.** In all instances the over-riding consideration will be the safety of the children. It is acknowledged that the children enjoy the experience of "playing" in the rain and in slippery /muddy conditions.

## Operational Matters

- Coordinators' Meeting Area: Should the need arise; will be inside the Clubrooms (See plan).
- Parking: There will be parking available in the beach parking area adjacent to the ground, (off Fred Burton way) and on verges where not signposted as no parking areas. Overflow parking is available at the beach front. For safety and access reasons, parking is strictly prohibited anywhere in the driveway access to the clubrooms. West Coast JFC volunteers will be on patrol during the day.
- Rubbish: There will be plenty of rubbish bins available on the day, please assist the organisers by encouraging use of these bins.
- Goal Flags & Goal Umpires: All teams to supply goal flags and goal umpires for each game.
- Footballs: Claremont Football District will supply the game balls.
- Umpires: Auskick coaches will umpire the games. Not CFC players.
- Centrally Controlled Siren: The siren will be centrally controlled and all games to operate from this. Please ensure your teams are in position and ready to play. The siren will be blown on time to commence the next game regardless if the teams are ready or not.
- First Aid: All teams are to bring a first aid kit for minor injuries. A 'First Aid Post' will be situated outside the Clubrooms.
- Football Gear/Jumpers: All teams to supply their own football gear i.e. shorts, socks, boots and jumpers. Please bring a set of bibs just in case there is a jumper clash on the day.

## AUSKICK RULES

1. There aren't zones at the 2021 Auskick Gala Day. The coaches should still be instructing their kids to be in their areas (forward, mid or back)
2. When the ball is thrown up in general play, players will be told to return to their original position. The CFC Player(s) is asked to not throw the ball up until this is done.
3. No tackling or bumping – non- contact.



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4. Only one bounce permitted.
5. No soccering permitted.
6. Ball out of bounds – Last team to touch the ball loses possession with the umpire nominating a player to kick in.
7. Ball thrown up in general play – The umpire will nominate two players of similar size.
8. Every child to receive a kick if possible, encouraging any marks, etc.
9. No “grabbing” the ball from the player who has possession.
10. Once a player has the ball, they should be allowed to dispose of it. (Give them a countdown of THREE, TWO, ONE if they take too long)
11. Ensure players keep their feet and do not dive on the ball. Pay a free kick against repeat offenders.
12. All coach/umpires to take possession of the match ball after each game and leave it in the middle of the playing oval.
